Newsflash: Mileage rate reduced as of January 1, 2009.

Due to a reduction in the Internal Revenue Service mileage reimbursement rate, a reduction was also triggered for medical mileage reimbursement for injured workers' in California.

In a press release issued on December 12, 2008, the State of California announced that the mileage reimbursement rate for state employees would be reduced from 58.5 cents per mile to 55 cents per mile.

The medical mileage reimbursement rate for injured workers is the same as the mileage reimbursement for state employees. As a result, the rate of medical mileage reimbursement for injured workers in California will be reduced to 55 cents per mile for all travel occurring on or after January 1, 2009.
