IMPORTANT REMINDER!

In all matters wherein the Agreed Medical Evaluator or Panel Qualified Medical Evaluator process has been invoked, the Division of Workers Compensation has created new forms for the parties to use. These forms became effective on February 17, 2009 and must be used in all instances thereafter.

Our readers will note that Form 105 is to be used in cases involving unrepresented applicants and Form 106 is to be used in cases involving represented applicants. A link to the forms is included below for your reference.

Please note that failure to use these forms or to fully and properly complete these forms when requesting a Panel Qualified Medical Evaluator will likely result in the rejection of the request and resulting delays.
